

Prefix & suffix

Prefix: it comes before the word and changes its meaning.

- Opposites

Agree \longleftrightarrow disagree

Legal \longleftrightarrow illegal

Direct \longleftrightarrow indirect

⋮

Moral \longleftrightarrow immoral

Fair \longleftrightarrow unfair

Responsible \longleftrightarrow irresponsible

Suffix: it comes after the word and changes its form to an adjective, an adverb, a noun, a verb.

Example:

- The suffix “**ty**” is added to an adjective to form a noun.

Stupid \longleftrightarrow Stupid**ty**

- The suffix “**y**” is added to a noun to form an adjective.

Spice \longleftrightarrow Spic**y**
